Iowa Code § 96.3 - Monetary Determination

STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Stacy Wickman (claimant) appealed an on-line monetary determination dated October 3, 2013, which reported wages from Stella's, LLC and Cedar Rapids Red Frog, LLC. Due notice was issued scheduling the matter for a telephone hearing to be held on November 26, 2013. Because a decision fully favorable to the party could be made based on the administrative record, a hearing was deemed unnecessary.

ISSUE:

The issue is whether the claimant's monetary determination is accurate.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The administrative law judge, having reviewed and considered all of the evidence in the record, finds that: The claimant filed an original claim for job insurance benefits effective September 29 2013. A monetary determination was issued effective October 3, 2013 which shows wages from Stella's, LLC (employer account number 523045) and Cedar Rapids Red Frog, LLC (employer account number 531070). The claimant never worked for these businesses, which are owned by one individual.

Both businesses are reporting wages for Benjamin Zieser under the claimant's Social Security number, which is one number different than the claimant's. All parties have been notified of the error and the employer is taking steps to get the problem corrected.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

The administrative law judge has carefully reviewed the information in the administrative file and concludes that a clerical error was made. This matter will be Remanded to the Tax Unit to correct the Social Security number for Benjamin Zieser.

DECISION:

The monetary determination dated October 3, 2013 is incorrect and the matter is remanded to the Tax Section to have the Social Security number corrected for Benjamin Zieser and to remove these earnings from the claimant's wage records.
