## DECISION

## UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS ARE DENIED

The Claimant appealed this case to the Employment Appeal Board. The members of the Employment Appeal Board reviewed the entire record. The Appeal Board finds the administrative law judge's decision is correct. With the following modification, the administrative law judge's Findings of Fact and Reasoning and Conclusions of Law are adopted by the Board as its own. The administrative law judge's decision is **AFFIRMED** with the following **MODIFICATION**:

The Employment Appeal Board would modify the administrative law judge's Reasoning and Conclusions of Law to include the following as supportive legal analysis:

Because there is no record to support the Employer participated in the fact-finding within the meaning of 871 IAC 24.10, the Claimant's overpayment for regular unemployment benefits in the amount of \$1,268.00 is waived, and the Employer's account shall not be charged. However, the Claimant continues to be liable for the \$3600 she received in Federal Pandemic Unemployment Assistance.
