STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The claimant, Natalie Dorn, filed an appeal from an unemployment insurance decision dated March 28, 2017, reference 03, which denied benefits. A telephone hearing was scheduled on April 26, 2017, at 10:00 a.m. Prior to the hearing date, the claimant/appellant submitted a written request to withdraw this appeal. The hearing was canceled due to this written appeal withdrawal.

ISSUE:

Should the request to dismiss or withdraw the appeal be granted?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The claimant, the appealing party, requested to withdraw the appeal. The request was submitted in writing and postmarked on April 10, 2017. The Iowa Workforce Development Unemployment Insurance Appeals Bureau received the written withdrawal on April 11, 2017.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

An appellant may submit a written request to withdraw his or her appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision. Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1).

Based on the available record in the appeal file, and in accordance with the applicable statutes and rules, the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

The appealing party's written withdrawal of this appeal of the unemployment insurance decision dated March 28, 2017, reference 03, is approved. That decision shall stand and remain in full force and effect.

The hearing scheduled on April 26, 2017, at 10:00 a.m. is canceled.
