Section 96.3-7 - Recovery of Overpayment of Benefits

## **STATEMENT OF THE CASE:**

The claimant appealed an unemployment insurance decision dated November 17, 2015, (reference 04), that concluded he was overpaid \$664.00 in unemployment insurance benefits. A telephone hearing was held on December 31, 2015. Proper notice of the hearing was given to the claimant. The claimant participated in the hearing. Based on the evidence, the arguments of the claimant, and the law, the following findings of fact, reasoning and conclusions of law, and decision are entered.

#### ISSUE:

Has the claimant been overpaid benefits?

#### FINDINGS OF FACT:

The claimant filed a new claim for unemployment insurance benefits with an effective date of September 27, 2015. The claimant filed for and received a total of \$664.00 in unemployment insurance benefits for the two weeks ending October 10, 2015. The unemployment insurance decision that disqualified the claimant from receiving unemployment insurance benefits has been affirmed.

### **REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:**

The issue in this case is whether the claimant was overpaid unemployment insurance benefits.

Iowa Code § 96.3-7 provides in pertinent part:

- 7. Recovery of overpayment of benefits.
- a. If an individual receives benefits for which the individual is subsequently determined to be ineligible, even though the individual acts in good faith and is not otherwise at fault, the benefits shall be recovered. The department in its discretion may recover the

overpayment of benefits either by having a sum equal to the overpayment deducted from any future benefits payable to the individual or by having the individual pay to the department a sum equal to the overpayment.

Since the decision disqualifying the claimant has been affirmed, the claimant was overpaid \$664.00 in unemployment insurance benefits.

### **DECISION:**

The	unemployme	nt insurance	decision	dated	Novembe	r 17,	2015,	(reference	04),	is a	affirmed.
The	claimant was	overpaid \$66	64.00 in u	nemplo	yment ins	uran	ce ben	efits, which	must	be	repaid.
