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### STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Isaac Thomas filed an appeal from a decision issued by Iowa Workforce Development (the Department) dated December 23, 2014 (reference 03). In this decision, the Department determined that Thomas was ineligible to receive unemployment insurance benefits effective December 14, 2014 because he failed to report for a reemployment and eligibility assessment.

The case was transmitted from Workforce Development to the Department of Inspections and Appeals on January 9, 2015 and a hearing was scheduled for February 9, 2015. Prior to the hearing, the Department provided information indicating January 27, 2015, the Department restored Thomas' eligibility for benefits effective December 14, 2014, provided he meets the other eligibility requirements.

The Department's most recent action has made the Appellant's case moot as the decision he appealed has been reversed.

### **DECISION**

The Appellant's appeal is dismissed as moot. The Department has amended its decision to reverse the disqualification imposed by its December 23, 2014 decision. The Department shall take any action necessary to implement this decision.

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
