871 IAC 26.8(1) – Withdrawal of Appeal

STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The claimant filed a timely appeal from an unemployment insurance decision dated July 1, 2004, reference 02, which ruled that he had been overpaid for the week ending May 8, 2004. Due notice was issued for a hearing to be held September 1, 2004. Prior to the date of the hearing, the appellant requested that the appeal be withdrawn.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Having examined all matters of record, the administrative law judge finds: The claimant, the appellant in this matter, has requested that the appeal be withdrawn.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

A rule found 871 IAC 26.8(1) allows the administrative law judge to grant an appellant's request for the withdrawal of its appeal. A review of all matters of record persuades the administrative law judge that it is appropriate to allow the withdrawal of this appeal.

DECISION:

The unemployment insurance decision dated July 1, 2004, reference 02, remains in effect as if no appeal had been filed. The claimant was overpaid \$368.00 for the week ending May 8, 2004. The benefits have been repaid.
