#### STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The claimant appealed a representative's January 8, 2014 determination (reference 02) that held her ineligible to receive benefits because she had been injured and was unable to work. On March 17, 2014, the claimant's attorney faxed a letter to the Appeals Bureau indicating the claimant was withdrawing her appeal. Based on the claimant's withdrawal request, the administrative record, and the law, the administrative law judge enters the following findings of fact, reasoning and conclusions of law, and decision.

#### FINDINGS OF FACT:

The claimant withdrew her appeal from a representative's January 8, 2014 determination (reference 01). The claimant faxed a written withdrawal request to the Appeals Bureau on March 17, 2014.

### **REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:**

871 IAC 26.8(1) provides:

(1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of the presiding officer to whom the case is assigned. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is tape-recorded by the presiding officer.

The claimant's request to withdraw her appeal is approved.

## **DECISION:**

The representative's January 8, 2014 determination (reference 021) is affirmed. The claimant's withdrawal request is approved. This means the claimant is ineligible to receive benefits as of December 15, 2013. The claimant remains ineligible until she reopens her claim and establishes her ability to and availability for work.
