# STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The issue of timeliness was raised when the Claimant filed an appeal that was faxed on November 21, 2015, one day beyond the statutory deadline of November 20, 2015. The reason for the delay was because of inclement weather and the Claimant was unable to return to the store to re-fax her appeal until the following day, as the phone line was continuously busy the previous day. For this reason, we find good cause has been established for the late appeal, and the board shall consider it to be timely.

The Claimant appealed this case to the Employment Appeal Board. The members of the Employment Appeal Board reviewed the entire record. The Appeal Board finds the administrative law judge's decision is correct. The administrative law judge's Findings of Fact and Reasoning and Conclusions of Law are adopted by the Board as its own. The administrative law judge's decision is **AFFIRMED**.

The Employment Appeal Board would correct the administrative law judge's Reasoning and Conclusions of Law, page two, first paragraph to reflect that the Claimant is <i>not</i> eligible to receive unemployment insurance benefits.
