Section 96.4-4 – Second Benefit Year Qualification

## STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Barbara J. Segura (claimant) appealed a representative's November 20, 2013 decision (reference 01) that concluded the claimant was not eligible to receive unemployment insurance benefits for a second benefit year because the claimant had not been paid insured wages of at least \$250.00 since establishing her prior benefit year. A hearing notice was mailed to the claimant's last-known address of record for a telephone hearing to be held on December 23, 2013, scheduled for hearing at 12:00 p.m. The claimant failed to respond to the hearing notice and provide a telephone number at which she could be reached for the hearing and did not participate in the hearing. Based on a review of the information in the administrative file and the law, the administrative law judge enters the following findings of fact, reasoning and conclusions of law, and decision.

#### **ISSUE:**

Is the claimant eligible to receive unemployment insurance benefits for a second benefit year?

#### FINDINGS OF FACT:

After a separation from employment on or about November 9, 2013, the claimant established a claim for unemployment insurance benefits for a claim year beginning November 11, 2012, expiring November 10, 2013. After the expiration of that 2012 claim year, she sought to establish a subsequent claim year effective November 10, 2013. Between November 11, 2012 and November 10, 2013, the claimant did not earn wages in excess of \$250.00.

### **REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:**

If an individual has drawn benefits in any benefit year, the individual must, during or subsequent to that year, work in and be paid wages totaling at least \$250.00 as a condition to receive benefits in the next benefit year. Iowa Code § 96.4-4.

The evidence shows that the claimant has not earned or been paid at least \$250.00 in covered wages since establishing her prior benefit year effective November 10, 2013. The claimant is not eligible for benefits in a subsequent benefit year until that occurs.

# DECISION:

The representative's November 20, 2013 decision (reference 01) is affirmed. The claimant is not entitled to receive unemployment insurance benefits during the claim year beginning November 10, 2013.
