STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Lori Henderson, Claimant, filed an appeal from the August 1, 2018, (reference 01), unemployment insurance decision that denied benefits because she voluntarily quit her employment with 1227 J Avenue Corporation without good cause attributable to the employer. The parties were properly notified of the hearing. A telephone hearing was held on September 13, 2018 at 3:00 p.m. Claimant participated. Employer participated through Steven Bray, co-owner. Claimant/appellant withdrew her appeal on the record.

ISSUE:

Whether the request to withdraw the appeal should be granted.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The claimant, the appealing party, requested to withdraw the appeal on the record during the hearing on September 13, 2018.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

An appellant may request to withdraw his or her appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision. Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1). An oral request must be tape-recorded by the presiding officer. *Id*.

Based on the available record in the appeal file, and in accordance with the applicable statutes and rules, the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

The appealing party's request to withdrawal her appeal of the unemployment insurance decision dated August 1, 2018, reference 01, is approved. That decision shall stand and remain in full force and effect.
