DECISION

The Claimant appealed this case to the Employment Appeal Board. Two members of the Employment Appeal Board reviewed the entire record. The Appeal Board finds the administrative law judge's decision is correct. The administrative law judge's Findings of Fact and Reasoning and Conclusions of Law are adopted by the Board as its own. The administrative law judge's decision is **AFFIRMED**.

The Board cannot waive the FPUC overpayment in the case based on the Claimant's untimely appeal. "[W]aiver determinations must be made on the facts and circumstance of each individual claim, blanket waivers are not permissible." UIPL 15-20, Change 1, Attachment I, p. I-3 (DOL ETA May 9, 2020). However, the Claimant may still request a waiver of his FPUC overpayment from Iowa Workforce Development. Instructions for requesting a waiver of this overpayment can be found at https://www.iowaworkforcedevelopment.gov/unemployment-insurance-overpayment-and-recovery. The Claimant should then carefully read and follow all instructions from Iowa Workforce on how to apply for waiver of FPUC, what information to supply, and how to appeal if necessary.
