STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The claimant appealed a decision dated October 26, 2020, reference 05, denying unemployment insurance benefits as of October 18, 2020. A hearing was not deemed necessary to be held in order to make a decision for reasons which will appear in the Findings of Fact.

ISSUE:

The issue is whether the appeal should be dismissed.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The administrative law judge, having considered all of the evidence in the record, finds that: A representative's October 26, 2020, decision (reference 05) concluded the claimant was not eligible to receive unemployment insurance benefits as of October 18, 2020, due to failure to report for reemployment and eligibility assessment on October 21, 2020. Another representative's decision was issued on December 9, 2020 (reference 06). It stated the claimant has since participated in the assessment and is eligible to receive unemployment insurance benefits as of October 18, 2020.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

For the reasons that follow, the administrative law judge concludes the claimant has established a good cause reason for having failed to report as directed.

The claimant was directed to report to the Agency. Since then, the claimant has reported. Benefits are allowed, provided the claimant is otherwise eligible. No hearing is necessary.

DECISION:

The representative's October 26, 2020, decision (reference 05) is dismissed. Benefits are allowed, provided the claimant is otherwise eligible. The hearing scheduled for December 31, 2020, at 10:00 a.m. is canceled.
