STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Judith Butters filed a timely appeal from a decision issued by Iowa Workforce Development (the Department) dated December 22, 2010, reference 01. In this decision, the Department determined that Ms. Butters was ineligible to receive unemployment insurance benefits from December 19 through December 25, 2010 because she did not establish justifiable cause for failing to participate in reemployment services.

The case was transmitted from Workforce Development to the Department of Inspections and Appeals on February 14, 2011 to schedule a contested case hearing. A Notice of Telephone Hearing was mailed to all parties on February 23, 2011. On March 25, 2011, the parties convened for a telephone appeal hearing before Administrative Law Judge Laura Lockard. Workforce advisor Theresa Glick represented the Department and appellant Judith Butters appeared. The Department submitted Exhibits 1 through Docket No. 11IWDUI043 Page 2

3, which were admitted as evidence in the case.

After some discussion on the record, the Department acknowledged that Ms. Butters had justifiable cause for failure to attend reemployment services for the dates in question. The Department determined that it would reverse its December 22, 2010 decision that disqualified Ms. Butters from receiving unemployment insurance benefits from December 19 through December 25, 2010.

The Department's determination to reverse the decision under appeal has made the appellant's case moot as she will receive the relief that she sought through the appeal process.

DECISION

The appellant's appeal is dismissed as moot. The Department shall reverse the disqualification for the week of December 19 through December 25, 2010. The Department shall take any action necessary to implement this decision.
