## NOTICE

## DECISION

The Claimant appealed this case to the Employment Appeal Board. The members of the Employment Appeal Board reviewed the entire record. The Appeal Board finds the administrative law judge's decision is correct. The administrative law judge's Findings of Fact and Reasoning and Conclusions of Law are adopted by the Board as its own. The administrative law judge's decision is **AFFIRMED**.

The Claimant requests the Board to waive her LWA overpayment. The Claimant may apply for a waiver with Iowa Workforce. Such a waiver request is made to Iowa Workforce Development. Instructions for requesting waiver of this overpayment can be found а at https://www.iowaworkforcedevelopment.gov/unemployment-insurance-overpayment-and-recovery. The Administrative Law Judge gave more detail at the end of his decision. The Claimant should carefully read and follow all instructions from Iowa Workforce on how to apply for waiver of any federal overpayments, what information to supply. The question of whether the LWA overpayment will be waived will be

determined by the outcome of any application for waiver the Claimant makes to IWD. We express no view on the matter at this time.
