Section 871 IAC 26.8(1) - Withdrawal of Appeal

STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

An appeal was filed from an unemployment insurance decision dated December 14, 2005, reference 02. A hearing was scheduled for March 27, 2006. During the hearing, the employer who was the appealing party requested the appeal be withdrawn.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

A request has been made by the appealing party to withdraw the appeal. The request was submitted orally and was recorded. The basis for withdrawing the appeal was that the employer was not a base period employer on the claim and the employer understood that its account was not currently subject to charge for benefits paid to the claimant.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

871 IAC 26.8(1) provides:

(1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of the presiding officer to whom the case is assigned. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is tape-recorded by the presiding officer.

The administrative law judge has reviewed the records and files herein and concludes that the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

The unemployment insurance decision dated December 14, 2005, reference 02, is affirmed. The decision granting benefits to the claimant remains in effect.
