STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Rhonda Chase, the claimant/appellant, filed an appeal from the March 12, 2021, (reference 02) unemployment insurance decision that denied benefits as of November 29, 2020. The parties were properly notified about the hearing. A telephone hearing was held on June 3, 2021. Ms. Chase participated and testified. The employer participated through Hilary Myers, store leader. Ms. Chase withdrew her appeal on the record.

ISSUES:

Should Ms. Chase's request to withdraw her appeal be granted?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Ms. Chase requested to withdraw her appeal on the record during the hearing on June 3, 2021.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

An appellant may submit a written request to withdraw an appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision. Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1). An oral request must be tape-recorded by the presiding officer. *Id.*

Based on the available record in the appeal file, and in accordance with the applicable statutes and rules, Ms. Chase's request to withdraw her appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

Ms. Chase's request to withdraw her appeal of the March 12, 2021 (reference 02) unemployment insurance decision is approved. That decision shall stand and remain in full force and effect.
