Section 96.3-7 – Recovery of Overpayments

STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Robert Slutts filed a timely appeal from an unemployment insurance decision dated October 14, 2008, reference 03, that ruled he had been overpaid unemployment insurance benefits in the gross amount of \$392.00 for the two weeks ending September 13, 2008 because of a fact-finding decision that disqualified him for refusing a suitable offer of work made by R J Personnel, Inc. After due notice was issued, a telephone hearing was held October 29, 2008 with Mr. Slutts participating. This matter is considered on a consolidated record with 08A-UI-09443-AT.

ISSUE:

Has the claimant been overpaid?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Having heard the testimony of the witness and having examined all of the evidence in the record, the administrative law judge finds: The fact-finding decision disqualifying Mr. Slutts for benefits has been reversed by the administrative law judge's decision in the companion case.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

The question is whether Mr. Slutts must repay the benefits he received for the two weeks ending September 13, 2008. He need not do so. The decision in the companion case has ruled in effect that Mr. Slutts was entitled to receive those benefits.

DECISION:

The unemployment insurance decision dated October 14, 2008, reference 03, is reversed. The claimant has not been overpaid for the two weeks ending September 13, 2008.
