## STATEMENT OF THE CASE

On January 9, 2012, Iowa Workforce Development ("IWD") issued a decision, reference 03, finding Appellant/Claimant Christine Klapproth was overpaid \$1,128 for the three weeks between September 11, 2011 and October 10, 2011 for failing to report wages earned with Dave's Law Care & Snow. Klapproth appealed.

On February 20, 2012 IWD transferred the case to the Iowa Department of Inspections and Appeals, Division of Administrative Hearing to schedule a contested case hearing. On February 24, 2012, my office received a withdrawal of appeal from Klapproth, stating that after IWD reduced the amount that it claimed she owed to \$376 she was not disputing the \$376 amount. IWD's rules allow an appellant to withdraw an appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision, with the approval of the administrative law judge.<sup>1</sup> The request to withdraw the appeal is granted.

# DECISION

Klapproth's request to withdraw the appeal is granted. This matter is deemed withdrawn.
