STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

On October 26, 2020, Jamie Hoaglan (claimant/appellant) filed an appeal from the October 14, 2020 (reference 02) unemployment insurance decision that determined claimant had been overpaid benefits.

A telephone hearing is scheduled for December 17, 2020 at 8:35 a.m. The parties were properly notified of the hearing. Prior to the hearing date, the appellant submitted a written request to withdraw the appeal.

ISSUE:

Whether the request to withdraw the appeal should be granted.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Having reviewed all of the evidence in the record, the administrative law judge finds:

The appealing party requested to withdraw the appeal. The request was submitted in writing and sent via email on December 16, 2020.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

An appellant may submit a written request to withdraw an appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision. Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1). Based on the available record in the appeal file, and in accordance with the applicable statutes and rules, the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

The appealing party's request to withdraw the appeal of the October 14, 2020 (reference 02) unemployment insurance decision that determined claimant had been overpaid benefits is APPROVED. That decision shall stand and remain in full force and effect.

The hearing scheduled for December 17, 2020 at 8:35 a.m. is CANCELLED.
