STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

QPS Employment Group, Inc. (employer/appellant) filed an appeal from the April 27, 2020 (reference 02) unemployment insurance decision that allowed benefits.

A telephone hearing is scheduled for May 29, 2020 at 10 a.m. The parties were properly notified of the hearing. Prior to the hearing date, the appellant submitted a written request to withdraw the appeal.

ISSUE:

Whether the request to withdraw the appeal should be granted.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Having reviewed all of the evidence in the record, the administrative law judge finds:

The appealing party requested to withdraw the appeal. The request was submitted in writing and sent via email on May 28, 2020. The Iowa Workforce Development Unemployment Insurance Appeals Bureau received the written withdrawal of appeal the same date.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

An appellant may submit a written request to withdraw an appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision. Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1). Based on the available record in the appeal file, and in accordance with the applicable statutes and rules, the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

The appealing party's request to withdraw the appeal of the April 27, 2020 (reference 02) unemployment insurance decision is APPROVED. That decision shall stand and remain in full force and effect.

The hearing scheduled for May 29, 2020, at 10 a.m. is CANCELLED.
