Section 96.3-7 – Recovery of Overpayments

STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Sean B. Crawford filed a timely appeal from an unemployment insurance decision dated June 9, 2010, reference 08, that ruled he was overpaid \$11,966.00 for the 31 weeks ending May 22, 2010. After due notice was issued, a telephone hearing was held July 24, 2010, with Mr. Crawford participating. This matter is considered on a consolidated record with Appeal Number 10A-UI-09066-AT. The administrative law judge takes official notice of Agency benefit payment records.

ISSUE:

Has the claimant been overpaid?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Having heard the testimony of the witness and having examined all of the evidence in the record, the administrative law judge finds: Sean B. Crawford received emergency unemployment compensation benefits in the gross amount of \$11,966.00 through the state of Iowa for the 31 weeks ending May 22, 2010. The fact-finding decision holding him ineligible for those benefits has been reversed by the administrative law judge's decision in Appeal Number 10A-UI-09066-AT.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

The question is whether the claimant must repay the benefits he has received. The administrative law judge concludes that Mr. Crawford was entitled to receive the benefits in question and that they need not be repaid.

DECISION:

The unemployment insurance decision dated June 9, 2010, reference 08, is reversed. The claimant has not been overpaid for the 31 weeks ending May 22, 2010.
