871 IAC26.8(1) - Withdrawal of Appeal

**STATEMENT OF THE CASE:**

The Appeals Section set up an appeal as though Temprow Services, Inc. (employer) appealed a representative's May 13, 2009 decision (reference 03) that concluded Deborah L. Skold (claimant) was qualified to receive benefits when she declined an offer of work on April 13, 2009 because the pay was too low. After hearing notices were mailed to the parties' last-known address of record, a telephone hearing was held on June 9, 2009. The employer had not appealed this decision and requested that this appeal be dismissed. Based on the employer's dismissal request, the administrative record, and the law, the administrative law judge enters the following findings of fact, reasoning and conclusions of law, and decision.

**FINDINGS OF FACT:**

The employer had not appealed a representative's May 13, 2009 decision (reference 03) and requested that this appeal be dismissed. The employer's dismissal or withdrawal request was tape-recorded on June 9, 2009.

**REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:**

871 IAC 26.8(1) provides:

- (1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of the presiding officer to whom the case is assigned. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is tape-recorded by the presiding officer.

The employer's request to dismiss this appeal is approved.

**DECISION:**

The representative's May 13, 2009 decision (reference 03) is affirmed. The employer's dismissal request is approved. As of April 13, 2009, the claimant is not disqualified from receiving unemployment insurance benefits because she declined an offer of work because the pay was too low.
