STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

On July 10, 2020, the employer filed an appeal from the July 2, 2020, (reference 02) unemployment insurance decision that allowed benefits. The parties were properly notified about the hearing. A telephone hearing was scheduled for August 13, 2020. Prior to the scheduled hearing, employer requested to withdraw its appeal.

ISSUE:

Should the request to withdraw the appeal be granted?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The administrative law judge finds that: Employer has requested to withdraw the appeal of the decision that allowed claimant benefits. Employer submitted the request orally and it was recorded.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1) provides:

(1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of an administrative law judge or the manager or chief administrative law judge of the appeals bureau. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is tape-recorded by the presiding officer.

The administrative law judge has reviewed the records and files and concludes that employer's request to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

Employer's request to withdraw the appeal of the unemployment insurance decision dated July 2, 2020, (reference 02), that allowed benefits is approved. The decision allowing benefits to claimant shall stand and remain in full force and effect.
