STATEMENT OF THE CASE

The claimant, Darryl Turner, filed an appeal of a decision issued by Iowa Workforce Development (IWD) dated December 21, 2016, reference 02. IWD found Mr. Turner was disqualified to receive unemployment benefits from December 13, 2015, for failure to report for a reemployment and eligibility assessment on December 16, 2015. IWD transmitted the case to the Department of Inspections and Appeals to schedule a contested case hearing.

However, on January 22, 2016, Iowa Workforce Development, by Workforce Advisor Mila Baier, issued an e-mail indicating that all benefits have been paid and there are no issues to resolve with attachment of a decision issued January 14, 2016, finding Mr. Turner eligible to receive unemployment benefits as of December 13, 2015. The claimant appears to have received the benefits sought through the appeal process. In light of this determination the appeal is dismissed. 481 IAC 10.24(1).

DECISION

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT the claimant's appeal is dismissed as no issue remains for resolution.
