Section 96.3-7 - Recovery of Overpayment of Benefits

STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The claimant appealed an unemployment insurance decision dated December 07, 2015, (reference 03) that concluded he was overpaid \$760.00 in unemployment insurance benefits. A telephone hearing was held on December 23, 2015. The claimant waived notice of the hearing on the overpayment issue during the telephone hearing held on the appeal of the decision related to his separation that resulted in the overpayment. The claimant participated in the hearing. Based on the evidence, the arguments of the claimant, and the law, the following findings of fact, reasoning and conclusions of law, and decision are entered.

ISSUE:

Has the claimant been overpaid benefits?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The claimant filed a new claim for unemployment insurance benefits with an effective date of October 18, 2015. The claimant filed for and received a total of \$760.00 in unemployment insurance benefits for the four weeks between October 18, 2015 and November 14, 2015. The unemployment insurance decision that disqualified the claimant from receiving unemployment insurance benefits has been affirmed in a decision of the administrative law judge in appeal 15A-UI-13314-SC-T.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

The issue in this case is whether the claimant was overpaid unemployment insurance benefits.

Iowa Code § 96.7 provides, in pertinent part:

7. Recovery of overpayment of benefits.

a. If an individual receives benefits for which the individual is subsequently determined to be ineligible, even though the individual acts in good faith and is not otherwise at fault, the benefits shall be recovered. The department in its discretion may recover the

overpayment of benefits either by having a sum equal to the overpayment deducted from any future benefits payable to the individual or by having the individual pay to the department a sum equal to the overpayment.

Since the decision disqualifying the claimant has been affirmed, the claimant was overpaid \$760.00 in unemployment insurance benefits.

DECISION:

The unemployment insurance decision dated December 07, 2015, (reference 03) is affirmed. The claimant was overpaid \$760.00 in unemployment insurance benefits, which must be repaid.
