STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Stephen Vick, the claimant/appellant, filed an appeal from the February 3, 2021 (reference 01) unemployment insurance decision that denied benefits. The parties were properly notified of the hearing. A telephone hearing is scheduled for April 21, 2021, at 3:00 p.m. Prior to the hearing date, Mr. Vick submitted a written request to withdraw the appeal.

ISSUE:

Should Mr. Vick's request to withdraw his appeal be granted?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Having reviewed all of the evidence in the record, the administrative law judge finds: Mr. Vick requested to withdraw the appeal. The request was submitted in writing and sent via email on March 29, 2021. The Iowa Workforce Development Unemployment Insurance Appeals Bureau received the written withdrawal of appeal on March 29, 2021.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

An appellant may submit a written request to withdraw an appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision. Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1). Based on the available record in the appeal file, and in accordance with the applicable statutes and rules, Mr. Vick's request to withdraw his appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

Mr. Vick's request to withdraw his appeal of the February 3, 2021 (reference 01) unemployment insurance decision is approved. That decision shall stand and remain in full force and effect.

The hearing scheduled for April 21, 2021 at 3:00 p.m. is cancelled.
