STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

On April 11, 2022, Nordstrom Inc (employer/appellant) filed an appeal from the Iowa Workforce Development decision dated March 31, 2022 (reference 01) that allowed unemployment insurance benefits based on a finding claimant was dismissed from work on February 23, 2022 without a showing of misconduct.

A telephone hearing was scheduled for May 20, 2022 at 2 p.m. The parties were properly notified of the hearing. Prior to the hearing date, the appellant submitted a written request to withdraw the appeal.

ISSUE:

Whether the request to withdraw the appeal should be granted.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Having reviewed all of the evidence in the record, the administrative law judge finds:

The appealing party requested to withdraw the appeal. The request was submitted in writing and sent via fax on May 19, 2022.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

An appellant may submit a written request to withdraw an appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision. Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1). Based on the available record in the appeal file, and in accordance with the applicable statutes and rules, the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

The appealing party's request to withdraw the appeal of the decision dated March 31, 2022 (reference 01) that allowed unemployment insurance benefits based on a finding claimant was dismissed from work on February 23, 2022 without a showing of misconduct is APPROVED. That decision shall stand and remain in full force and effect.

The hearing scheduled for May 20, 2022, at 2 p.m. is CANCELLED.
