Section 96.3-7 – Recovery of Overpayments

**STATEMENT OF THE CASE:**

Grant C. Cashman filed a timely appeal from an unemployment insurance decision dated February 16, 2012, reference 04, that ruled he had been overpaid Emergency Unemployment Compensation benefits in the gross amount of \$1,273.52 for the five weeks ending February 4, 2012. Due notice was issued for a telephone hearing to be held March 9, 2012. After reviewing all matters of record, the administrative law judge concludes that a formal hearing is not required.

**ISSUE:**

Was the claimant overpaid Emergency Unemployment Compensation benefits for the five weeks ending February 4, 2012?

**FINDINGS OF FACT:**

Grant C. Cashman received Emergency Unemployment Compensation benefits in the gross amount of \$1,273.52 for the five weeks ending February 4, 2012. He should not have received those benefits because he was monetarily eligible for state unemployment insurance benefits in the gross amount of \$1,815.00 for the weeks in question. The decision on appeal was intended to document that Mr. Cashman had been initially paid federal benefits when he should have been paid state benefits. The agency has corrected its error and has paid Mr. Cashman the difference. He owes nothing to the agency at this time.

**REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:**

The evidence establishes that Mr. Cashman initially received federal Emergency Unemployment Compensation benefits for weeks that he should have been receiving regular state unemployment insurance benefits. The amount of the federal benefits paid in error has been recouped by the agency and the difference has been paid to Mr. Cashman. He owes the agency nothing at this time.

**DECISION:**

The unemployment insurance decision dated February 16, 2012, reference 04, is modified. The claimant was overpaid Emergency Unemployment Compensation benefits totaling \$1,273.52 for the five weeks ending February 4, 2012. He was underpaid state unemployment insurance benefits in the amount of \$1,815.00 for the same weeks. The claimant owes nothing to the agency. The agency has reimbursed Mr. Cashman for the underpayment of state benefits.
