871 IAC 26.8(1) – Withdrawal of Appeal

**STATEMENT OF THE CASE:**

The employer filed a timely appeal from an unemployment insurance decision dated January 19, 2007, reference 01, that allowed benefits to the claimant. Due notice was issued for a telephone hearing to be held February 13, 2007. Prior to the hearing, the employer requested that the appeal be withdrawn.

**ISSUE:**

Should the request to withdraw the appeal be granted?

**FINDINGS OF FACT:**

Having examined all matters of record, the administrative law judge finds: The employer, the appellant in this matter, has requested that the appeal be withdrawn.

**REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:**

A rule found at 871 IAC 26.8(1) allows the administrative law judge to grant an appellant's request for the withdrawal of its appeal. A review of all matters of record persuades the administrative law judge that it is appropriate to allow the withdrawal of this appeal.

**DECISION:**

The unemployment insurance decision dated January 19, 2007, reference 01, remains in effect. The claimant is entitled to receive unemployment insurance benefits, provided he is otherwise eligible.
