Section 96.4-3 – Active Work Search

STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

H & R Block filed a timely appeal from an unemployment insurance decision dated May 4, 2012, reference 03, that allowed unemployment insurance benefits to Jacqueline J. Jones but required that Ms. Jones commence an active work search. The purpose of the appeal was to allow a waiver of the work search requirement. After reviewing all matters of record, the administrative law judge concludes that a formal hearing is not required.

ISSUE:

Must the claimant conduct an active work search?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Jacqueline J. Jones remains attached to H & R Block, her former employer. The employer contemplates recalling Ms. Jones to work. It requests that she not be required to conduct a work search.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

lowa Code section 96.4-3 ordinarily requires that claimants conduct an active work search each week that they request unemployment insurance benefits. A work search may be waived, however, if the individual remains attached to the former employer. The evidence in this record establishes that Ms. Jones remains attached to H & R Block and that the company requests that the work search requirement be waived.

DECISION:

The unemployment insurance decision dated May 4, 2012, reference 03, is modified. The claimant remains entitled to receive unemployment insurance benefits, provided she is otherwise eligible. The work search requirement is waived.
