STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The claimant filed a timely appeal from the May 26, 2010, reference 04, decision that denied her request for emergency unemployment benefits on her Iowa claim because she is eligible for regular unemployment benefits in the State of Illinois effective October 11, 2009. Administrative Law Judge Randy Stephenson conducted an initial hearing on this matter in appeal 10A-UI-07898-ST in which the claimant did not participate and benefits were denied. The claimant appealed the decision and the Employment Appeal Board remanded for a new hearing in an order dated September 8, 2010, because the claimant failed to participate through no fault of her own. After due notice was issued, a hearing was held by telephone conference call before Administrative Law Judge Julie Elder on November 5, 2010. The claimant participated in the hearing.

ISSUE:

The issue is whether the claimant is eligible for emergency unemployment benefits on her Iowa claim.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Having reviewed all of the evidence in the record, the administrative law judge finds: The Findings of Fact set forth in the decision in appeal 10A-UI-07898-ST are adopted and incorporated herein as if set forth at length.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

The Reasoning and Conclusions of Law of the administrative law judge in appeal 10A-UI-07898-ST are adopted and incorporated herein as if set forth at length.

DECISION:

The May 26, 2010, reference 04, decision is affirmed. The claimant is not eligible for emergency unemployment benefits on her Iowa claim because she is eligible for regular unemployment benefits in the State of Illinois effective October 11, 2009.
