871 IAC 26.8(1) – Withdrawal of Appeal

STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The claimant filed an appeal from the September 15, 2010, reference 02, decision that held that the claimant was ineligible for unemployment insurance benefits. A telephone hearing was scheduled for October 19, 2010. Before the hearing began, the claimant requested orally that his appeal be withdrawn. The claimant's request was recorded by digital audiotape.

ISSUE:

Whether the appellant should be permitted to withdraw his appeal.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The administrative law judge, having reviewed the record, makes the following findings of fact: On October 19, 2010, the claimant made an oral request to withdraw his appeal filed on September 14, 2010.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

871 IAC 26.8(1) provides:

- (1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of the presiding officer to whom the case is assigned. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is tape-recorded by the presiding officer.

The administrative law judge has reviewed the records and files herein and concludes that the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

The request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal is approved. The Agency representative's decision dated September 15, 2010, reference 02, shall stand and remain in full force and effect.
