Dismissal of Appeals – 481 Iowa Administrative Code 10.24

STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Claimant/Appellant Heather Carpenter appealed two decisions issued by Respondent Iowa Workforce Development (“IWD”) dated August 23, 2012, reference 05, and August 28, 2012, reference 06. In reference 05, IWD found Carpenter failed to attend a reemployment and eligibility assessment on August 17, 2012, and denied benefits as of August 12, 2012. In reference 06, IWD found Carpenter received an overpayment of

\$243 for the week of August 12, 2012 through August 18, 2012 because she was disqualified from receiving benefits that week.

IWD transmitted the administrative files to the Department of Inspections and Appeals on September 18, 2012 to schedule a contested case hearing.

On October 11, 2012, I received a decision from IWD finding Carpenter is eligible for unemployment insurance benefits effective August 12, 2012. The benefits that are the subject of this appeal have been released to Carpenter. Because Carpenter was eligible for benefits for the week of August 12, 2012 through August 18, 2012, no overpayment occurred. IWD requests the appeal be dismissed. Because no issues remain for resolution in this administrative appeal, the appeal is dismissed in favor of Carpenter.¹

DECISION

These appeals are dismissed because no issues remain to be resolved.
