STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

On January 21, 2021, the claimant appealed the unemployment insurance decision dated January 12, 2021 (reference 01) that denied benefits. A hearing was scheduled for March 30, 2021. Prior to the hearing being held, the claimant requested to withdraw the appeal.

ISSUE:

Should the request to withdraw the appeal be granted?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The administrative law judge finds that: Claimant has requested to withdraw the appeal of the decision that denied benefits. Claimant submitted the request in writing.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1) provides:

(1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of an administrative law judge or the manager or chief administrative law judge of the appeals bureau. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is tape-recorded by the presiding officer.

The administrative law judge has reviewed the records and files and concludes that claimant's request to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

Claimant's request to withdraw the appeal of the unemployment insurance decision dated January 12, 2021, (reference 01) that denied benefits, is approved. The decision denying benefits shall stand and remain in full force and effect.
