STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Amy S Follmuth, the claimant/appellant, filed an appeal from the November 9, 2020 (reference 01) unemployment insurance decision that denied benefits. The parties were properly notified of the hearing. A telephone hearing was held on January 22, 2021, at 3:00 p.m. Ms. Follmuth participated. Ms. Follmuth withdrew her appeal on the record. Official notice was taken of the administrative record.

ISSUE:

Should Ms. Follmuth's request to withdraw the appeal be granted.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Mr. Follumth was approved for Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA) benefits effective July 19, 2020.

Ms. Follmuth requested to withdraw her appeal on the record during the hearing on January 22, 2021.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

An appellant may submit a written request to withdraw an appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision. Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1). An oral request must be tape-recorded by the presiding officer. *Id*.

Based on the available record in the appeal file, and in accordance with the applicable statutes and rules, Ms. Follmuth's request to withdraw her appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

Ms. Follmuth's request to withdraw her appeal of the November 9, 2020 (reference 01) unemployment insurance decision is approved. That decision shall stand and remain in full force and effect.
