STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Claimant/Appellant Timothy Nedoba appealed a decision issued by Respondent Iowa Workforce Development ("IWD") dated December 13, 2012, reference 04, finding Nedoba failed to attend a reemployment and eligibility assessment on December 12, 2012, and denying benefits as of December 9, 2012.

IWD transmitted the administrative file to the Department of Inspections and Appeals on January 2, 2013 to schedule a contested case hearing.

A contested case hearing was scheduled for January 22, 2013. On January 14, 2013, IWD submitted a decision dated December 24, 2012, reference 05, finding Nedoba had participate in reemployment services removing the disqualification effective December 9, 2012. IWD requests the appeal be dismissed. Because no issues remain for resolution in this administrative appeal, the appeal is dismissed.¹

DECISION

This appeal is dismissed because no issues remain to be resolved.
