**STATEMENT OF THE CASE:**

The claimant filed a timely appeal from the January 12, 2010, reference 02, decision that denied him extended training benefits. After due notice was issued, a hearing was held on April 17, 2010. The claimant did participate. Iowa Workforce Development issued another representative's decision on January 23, 2010, reference 03 that allowed extended training benefits and reversed reference 02.

**ISSUE:**

Is the claimant entitled to extended training benefits?

**FINDINGS OF FACT:**

Having reviewed all of the evidence in the record, the administrative law judge finds: The representative's decision the claimant appealed from dated January 12, 2010 reference 02 denied benefits effective December 13, 2009. In a representative's decision dated January 23, 2010, reference 03 amending reference 02, the agency reversed that denial and allowed benefits effective December 13, 2009. It was found that the claimant was entitled to Department approved training.

**REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:**

Inasmuch as the agency reversed the prior disqualification prior to the hearing, there is no issue for the administrative law judge to adjudicate. Department approved training is allowed.

**DECISION:**

The representative's decision dated January 12, 2010, reference 02, is reversed so as to be consistent with the subsequent agency action. Department approved training is allowed.
