871 IAC 26.8(1) - Withdrawal of Appeal

**STATEMENT OF THE CASE:**

The claimant appealed a representative's April 15, 2010 decision (reference 01) that concluded she was not qualified to receive benefits and the employer's account was exempt from charge because the claimant voluntarily quit her employment for reasons that do not qualify her to receive benefits. A hearing was scheduled on June 11, 2010. Prior to the hearing, the claimant's attorney faxed a withdrawal request to the Appeals Section. Based on the claimant's withdrawal request, the administrative record, and the law, the administrative law judge enters the following findings of fact, reasoning and conclusions of law, and decision.

**FINDINGS OF FACT:**

The claimant withdrew her appeal from the representative's April 15, 2010 decision. The claimant's withdrawal request was faxed to the Appeals Section on June 10, 2010.

**REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:**

871 IAC 26.8(1) provides:

- (1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of the presiding officer to whom the case is assigned. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is tape-recorded by the presiding officer.

The claimant's request to withdraw her appeal is approved.

**DECISION:**

The representative's April 15, 2010 decision (reference 01) is affirmed. The claimant's withdrawal request is approved. As of March 21, 2010, the claimant remains disqualified from receiving unemployment insurance benefits. This disqualification continues until she has been paid ten times her weekly benefit amount for insured work, provided she is otherwise eligible. The employer's account is not subject to charge.
