STATEMENT OF THE CASE

On October 24, 2013, Iowa Workforce Development (IWD) issued a decision finding Liza M. Roza not eligible to receive unemployment insurance benefits (UIB) because of her failure to report for a reemployment and eligibility assessment. Roza appealed.

On December 18, 2013, Roza contacted the administrative law judge and withdrew the appeal. IWD's rules allow an appellant to withdraw an appeal at any time prior to the

issuance of a decision, with the approval of the administrative law judge.¹ The request to withdraw the appeal is granted.

DECISION

Roza's request to withdraw her appeal is granted. The appeal is deemed withdrawn.
