STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Heidi B Lau, the claimant/appellant, filed an appeal from the February 5, 2021 (reference 02) unemployment insurance decision that denied REGULAR unemployment insurance benefits. The parties were properly notified of the hearing. A telephone hearing is scheduled for May 12, 2021 at 10:00 a.m. Prior to the hearing date, Ms. Lau submitted a written request to withdraw the appeal.

ISSUE:

Should Ms. Lau's request to withdraw her appeal be granted?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Having reviewed all of the evidence in the record, the administrative law judge finds: Ms. Lau requested to withdraw the appeal. The request was submitted in writing and sent by mail through the United State Postal Service on April 30, 2021. The Iowa Workforce Development Unemployment Insurance Appeals Bureau received the written withdrawal of appeal on May 3, 2021.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

An appellant may submit a written request to withdraw an appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision. Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1). Based on the available record in the appeal file, and in accordance with the applicable statutes and rules, Ms. Lau's request to withdraw her appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

Ms. Lau's request to withdraw her appeal of the February 5, 2021 (reference 02) unemployment insurance decision is approved. That decision shall stand and remain in full force and effect.

The hearing scheduled for May 12, 2021 at 10:00 a.m. is cancelled.
