Section 96.5-5 – Severance Pay

STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Janice N. Stocker filed a timely appeal from an unemployment insurance decision dated September 24, 2008, reference 01, that denied unemployment insurance benefits for the three weeks ending August 23, 2008, upon a finding that she had received severance pay from Pro-Team Carpet Care. After due notice was issued, a telephone hearing was held October 22, 2008, with Alicia Perez participating for the employer. Ms. Stocker did not respond to the hearing notice until after the hearing had ended.

ISSUE:

Did the claimant receive severance pay from Pro-Team Carpet Care?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Having heard the testimony of the witness and having examined all of the evidence in the record, the administrative law judge finds: Janice N. Stocker received no severance pay from Pro-Team Carpet Care.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

The question is whether the claimant's unemployment insurance benefits must be delayed because of severance pay from Pro-Team Carpet Care. The evidence in the record establishes that the claimant received no severance pay from this employer. See companion decision 08A-UI-08941-AT for a discussion of severance pay she received from Pinnacle Construction Group.

DECISION:

The unemployment insurance decision dated September 24, 2008, reference 01, is reversed. The claimant received no severance pay from Pro-Team Carpet Care.
