STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Express Services Inc. (employer/appellant) filed an appeal from the November 6, 2020 (reference 01) unemployment insurance decision that allowed benefits.

A telephone hearing is scheduled for January 15, 2021 at 11:30 a.m. The parties were properly notified of the hearing. Prior to the hearing date, the appellant submitted a written request to withdraw the appeal.

ISSUE:

Whether the request to withdraw the appeal should be granted.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Having reviewed all of the evidence in the record, the administrative law judge finds:

The appealing party requested to withdraw the appeal. The request was submitted in writing and sent via fax on January 8, 2021.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

An appellant may submit a written request to withdraw an appeal at any time prior to the issuance of a decision. Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1). DECISION:

The appealing party's request to withdraw the appeal of the November 6, 2020 (reference 01) unemployment insurance decision that allowed benefits is APPROVED. That decision shall stand and remain in full force and effect. The hearing scheduled for January 15, 2021 at 11:30 a.m. is CANCELLED.
