## STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

An appeal was filed from an unemployment insurance decision dated February 21, 2017, (reference 03) that found claimant overpaid \$720.00 for the nine weeks-ending January 14, 2017. A hearing was scheduled for March 27, 2017. Prior to the hearing being held, the appealant requested the appeal be withdrawn.

## ISSUE:

Should the request to withdraw the appeal be granted?

## **FINDINGS OF FACT:**

The administrative law judge finds that: The appealing party made a request to withdraw the appeal. The request was submitted in writing.

## **REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:**

Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1) provides:

(1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of the presiding officer to whom the case is assigned. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is [] recorded by the presiding officer.

The administrative law judge has reviewed the records and files herein and concludes that the appealing party's request to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

## **DECISION:**

The appealing party's request to withdraw the appeal of an unemployment insurance decision dated February 21, 2017, (reference 03) is approved, and the decision shall stand and remain in full force and effect.
