STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

The employer appealed a representative's October 30, 2009 decision (reference 01) that concluded the claimant was qualified to receive benefits because she had been discharged for nondisqualifying reasons. A hearing was scheduled on December 16, 2009. On December 10, the employer's representative, TALX, faxed a written withdrawal request. Based on the employer's withdrawal request, the administrative record, and the law, the administrative law judge enters the following findings of fact, reasoning and conclusions of law, and decision.

ISSUE:

At issue in this matter is whether the appellant herein should be allowed to withdraw its appeal.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The employer withdrew its appeal from a representative's October 30, 2009 decision. The employer's withdrawal request was faxed to the Appeals Section on December 10, 2009.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

871 IAC 26.8(1) provides:

(1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of the presiding officer to whom the case is assigned. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is tape-recorded by the presiding officer.

The employer's request to withdraw its appeal is approved.

DECISION:

The representative's October 30, 2009 decision (reference 01) is affirmed. The employer's withdrawal request is approved. The claimant remains qualified to receive unemployment insurance benefits as of October 11, 2009, provided she meets all other eligibility requirements. The employer's account may be charged for benefits paid to the claimant.
