STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

An appeal was filed from an unemployment insurance decision dated October 19, 2015 (reference 01). Before a hearing was scheduled in the matter, the claimant/appellant withdrew this appeal.

ISSUE:

Should the request to withdraw the appeal be granted?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The administrative law judge finds as follows: The claimant was required to respond to a letter of inquiry from Iowa Workforce Development by October 12, 2015. A decision was issued on October 19, 2015 (reference 01) denying his unemployment insurance benefits as of October 11, 2015; due to his failure to report as required. He filed an appeal on October 22, 2015; along with the completed letter of inquiry. The claimant, the appealing party, then requested to withdraw the appeal. The request was submitted in writing on October 28, 2015.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

Iowa Admin. Code r. 871-26.8(1) provides:

(1) An appeal may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a decision upon the request of the appellant and with the approval of the presiding officer to whom the case is assigned. Requests for withdrawal may be made in writing or orally, provided the oral request is tape-recorded by the presiding officer.

The administrative law judge reviewed the records and files herein, and concludes that the request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal should be approved.

DECISION:

The request of the appealing party to withdraw the appeal of the unemployment insurance decision dated October 19, 2015 (reference 01) is approved. The department shall take any action necessary to implement this decision.
