Section 96.4-7 – Reemployment Services

### STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

LeAnn Goodale (claimant) appealed a representative's October 18, 2004 decision (reference 01) that concluded she did not participate in reemployment services as required. After a hearing notice was mailed to the claimant's last-known address of record, a telephone hearing was held on November 23, 2004. The claimant did participate.

# FINDINGS OF FACT:

The administrative law judge, having considered all of the evidence in the record, finds that: The claimant filed a claim for unemployment insurance benefits with an effective date of July 11, 2004. The claimant was scheduled to participate in reemployment services as of September 2004, but could not attend because she was having oral surgery. She rescheduled her participation on October 12, 2004, but was sick with the flu. She was rescheduled to participate on November 17, 2004, but did not receive notice of the meeting. The claimant was not allowed to reschedule after November 17, 2004.

#### REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

Iowa Code Section 96.4-7 provides:

An unemployed individual shall be eligible to receive benefits with respect to any week only if the department finds that:

7. The individual participates in reemployment services as directed by the department pursuant to a profiling system, established by the department, which identifies individuals who are likely to exhaust benefits and be in need of reemployment services.

The claimant has failed to participate in reemployment services as required. She has established good cause for not having participated. She is not to receive unemployment insurance benefits.

# **DECISION:**

The representative's October 18, 2004 decision (reference 01) is reversed. The claimant is eligible to receive unemployment insurance benefits.
