STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Craig Yager (claimant) appealed an unemployment insurance decision dated September 29, 2014, (reference 01), which denied his request to backdate his claim prior to September 14, 2014. Before a hearing could be held, the administrative law judge was advised the Agency would be granting the relief requested by the claimant. Under these circumstances, no hearing is necessary.

ISSUE:

The issue is whether a hearing in this matter is necessary.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The administrative law judge, having reviewed and considered all of the evidence in the record, finds that: The decision from which the claimant has appealed will be rendered null and void by a subsequent fact-finding decision granting his request to backdate his claim.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

The question is whether a hearing in this matter is necessary and the administrative law judge concludes it is not. The Agency will be issuing a subsequent decision granting the claimant's request to backdate his claim so there are no issues to be resolved.

DECISION:

The unemployment insurance decision dated September 29, 2014, (reference 01), is considered null and void. The claimant's request to backdate his claim will be granted.
