D E C I S I O N

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The administrative law judge issued a decision in this matter on Decision 20, 2021. The decision was merely that the Claimant did not work for the business known as “Abrams Upholstery and Fabric,” but rather “Kalil Ajram and Allea Ajram” (073932-000). The decision thus did not affect benefit rights in any way.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

Pursuant to 486 IAC 3.1(2), “[a]ny person aggrieved by a job service decision of an administrative law judge may appeal to the employment appeal board” The Employment Appeal Board interprets an aggrieved person to be one who receives an unfavorable decision from the administrative law judge. Here the decision of the administrative law judge does not affect the benefit rights of the claimant. For this reason, the claimant's appeal must be and is dismissed.

DECISION:

The appeal of the 21A-UI-20902 is **DISMISSED**. The decision of the administrative law judge remains in full force and effect.
