STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Amanda T. Ferrari filed a timely appeal from an unemployment insurance decision dated October 11, 2007, reference 01, that disqualified her for benefits. Due notice was issued for a hearing to be held October 29, 2007. Prior to the date of the hearing, the unemployment insurance services division granted the relief requested by the claimant. That decision, dated October 23, 2007, reference 04, also relieved the employer of charges. Under these circumstances, no hearing is required.

ISSUE:

Is the claimant entitled to receive unemployment insurance benefits?

Should the employer be relieved of charges?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Having examined all matters of record, the administrative law judge finds: The Agency has ruled that the claimant's separation from employment with Nationwide Mutual Insurance Company was not a disqualifying event and that the claimant is eligible for unemployment insurance benefits. It has also relieved the employer of charges for those benefits.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

The question is whether a hearing needs to be held in this matter. The administrative law judge concludes that no hearing is necessary. The claimant had requested a reversal of the fact-finding decision disqualifying her for benefits. The unemployment insurance services division has issued a subsequent decision allowing benefits to the claimant and relieving the employer of charges, creating a win-win situation. No issues remain to be adjudicated.

DECISION:

The unemployment insurance decision dated October 11, 2007, reference 01, is reversed. The claimant is entitled to receive unemployment insurance benefits, provided she is otherwise eligible. No benefits shall be charged to the account of Nationwide Mutual Insurance Company.
