STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Rochelle R. Hayes filed a timely appeal from an unemployment insurance decision dated July 27, 2010, reference 03, that held her ineligible for unemployment insurance benefits upon a finding that she had failed to report to the Agency as directed. Due notice was issued for a telephone hearing to be held August 31, 2010. The claimant did not respond to the hearing notice. The administrative law judge takes official notice of Agency decision records.

ISSUE:

Did the claimant fail to report as directed?

FINDINGS OF FACT:

Having examined all matters of record, the administrative law judge finds: On August 12, 2010 the Agency issued a subsequent fact-finding decision finding that Ms. Hayes had just cause for failing to report as directed on July 25, 2010. The decision allowed benefits.

REASONING AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

The administrative law judge concludes from the evidence in this record that the relief requested by the claimant in her appeal has already been granted by the Agency. Therefore, the decision on appeal is reversed.

DECISION:

The unemployment insurance decision dated July 27, 2010, reference 03, is reversed. The claimant is entitled to receive unemployment insurance benefits, provided she is otherwise eligible.
